1. ENEMY:

- a. Enemy activity: Heavy enemy artillery and mortar fire, and well entrenched emplacements held up friendly advance during this period. Railroad strong point (3597) in left sector and strong points Factory (400675) and Buildings (415675) in middle sector were still to be reduced. The right sector was quiet.
- b. Enemy locations: None.
- c. Enemy firing: None.

2. OWN SITUATION:

- a. Own activity: Regiments felt out enemy positions by patrol. Sn fires were light; there was no change in mission.
- b. Own location: (1) Front Lines: Right center sectors- no change. Left sector-412670-409667-401668-397672-388677-380682-372679-371670-368668-362670-358662. (2) Arty locations: No change.
- c. Own firing: Observed Missions 3; 32 Rounds expended. Unobserved Missions 1; 4 Rounds expended. See annex 1 for own missions.
